



TRADEMARK REGISTRATION IN BRAZIL 14-1-20 APRIL AL-LOCATION AL-LOC

HOW IT WORKS?

To register a trademark in Brazil, it is necessary to apply to the National Institute of Industrial Property (INPI) and make the request, which will be examined in accordance with the Industrial Property Law and other administrative resolutions of the agency.

WHY REGISTER?

- Protection against acts of unfair competition.
- Right to prevent and notify the use of the trademark without proper authorization.
- Generating revenue through licensing, franchising or selling the brand.
- Guaranteed use in promotional materials without the risk of being sued or losing the entire investment.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- Registration Application Form;
- Description of the brand, name and trademark artwork;
- Dated and signed application petition;
- Power of attorney signed/stamp;
- Updated Registration Contracts of the requesting company;
- Identification documents of the partners.
